Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

I interrupt our study of the Ten Commandments to confirm the announcement made at the end of the Masses last weekend. Bishop Mark has asked me to begin a new mission as of the 1st of September in St Joseph's Church in Stockport. Building upon the ministry of the Sacred Heart Fathers and their devotion to the Eucharistic Heart of Jesus, the bishop would like to give that church a new mission. It will remain a parish, but it will also be a diocesan shrine of the Blessed Sacrament. It will be a place of perpetual adoration and prayer for all of the needs of the Church and the world, but it will have a special mandate to pray for vocations to the priesthood. It is an old and beautiful church which will be in need of a lot of work over the coming months and years, so there will be much to do in this regard. Since the shrine will serve the people of the whole area, I hope that you will all be able to come there to pray from time-to-time. After our discussions with the Vicar General, Canon Michael Gannon, this week, please find below a message about St Chad's and St Ann's parishes. We congratulate Fr Louis on his new appointment and let us pray for him as he goes forward. He has had much pastoral responsibility during the course of his ministry. Before his arrival here, he had the care of two parishes, while also teaching several courses in the seminary and being involved in its administration; so he has been well prepared for this mission.

As regards my final Masses at our parishes I would like to propose the following: I had already planned to take my annual two weeks of summer holidays in the middle of August, and with my flights already booked, I plan to still go ahead with that if possible. This means that I will celebrate my last Sunday Mass at St Ann's on the 7th of August at 11am. Perhaps we could have some refreshments together just after Mass on that day. I will then be absent for two weekends before having my final Mass at St Chad's on the 28th of August at 9:30am, also followed by refreshments. I look forward to spending some time with you after my final Mass in thanksgiving for all the graces of the past couple of years. It has been a great gift for me to have been here with you. I have learned a lot and feel privileged to have been able to minister and pray with you. Thank you sincerely for all the kindness and love that you have shown me since

my arrival. We have been through a lot together over the past couple of years. I will certainly continue to pray for you every day and I entrust myself to your prayers too.

Following the appointment of Father Sean Davidson to St Joseph's, Stockport, the Bishop has invited Father Louis Charuvila Pappy to undertake the pastoral care of St Ann's Cheadle Hulme and St Chad's Cheadle from 1st September, as Parochial Administrator resident at St Chad's presbytery with an office at St Ann's presbytery. The life of the two churches and parishes will be sustained by Father Louis's support and leadership and will continue to work closely with Christ Church parish, Heald Green.

Fr Louis will continue his chaplaincy work for the Syro-Malankara community in the Northwest of England. It may be necessary to make some changes to the parish schedules from the beginning of September in order to facilitate Father Louis's ministry with the Syro-Malankara Mass Centres in Sheffield, Liverpool and Northenden. Further information will be provided closer to the time.
