Greetings and Prayers from Fr. Louis.

In the Catholic Church, the Cardinals are appointed by the Pope for life, to advise the Pope in matters of the Church when he summons an ordinary council. They are formally called **the Sacred College of Cardinals.** There are 222 Cardinals, of whom, 121 are eligible to vote in a conclave to elect a new Pope. Baselious Cardinal Cleemis is one of those who has the power to vote. He is the current Major Archbishop-Catholicos of the Syrian Malankara Catholic Church, one of the Eastern Rite churches in full communion with the Catholic Church. He was named one of the College of Cardinals of the Catholic Church by Pope Benedict XVI on 24 November 2012.

The Catholic Church is the communion of different individual churches having their own Liturgy, Spirituality, Tradition, Hierarchy and Patrimony. At present there are 23 Eastern Autonomous Particular Churches which are in full communion with the Pope in Rome just as Roman Catholics are. The Syro- Malankara Catholic Church is one of the Eastern Rite Churches in full communion with the Pope. The Head of the Church according to the tradition of the Church is referenced as **Catholicos** and he is addressed as His Beatitude/ His Eminence.

His Beatitude Baselious Cardinal Cleemis is at present the Major- Archbishop Catholicos of the Syrian Malankara Catholic Church, residing in the Major Arch-Bishop's House, Pattom Trivandrum in the Capital City of Kerala. He is the Cardinal Priest of the Church of Saint Gregory VII in Rome, a Member of the Congregation of the Oriental Churches in Rome, a Member of the Pontifical Council for Inter-Religious Dialogue in Rome, a Member of the National Integration Council of the Prime Minister of India, a Former President of the Catholic Bishop's Conference of India, and at present the President of the Regional Catholic Bishop's Conference. **Your Beatitude, A Cordial and Big Welcome to Cheadle.**
