Sacrament of the Sick: the anointing of the sick is a sacrament for the sick which is sometimes mistakenly called the extreme unction or the Last Rites. It is designed to help the sick to be strengthened spiritually against temptation, discouragement and anxiety. It generates a sense of strength and peace to the sick person. It is the medicine of the soul. Often we are unable to manage the last moments of a person's life. We may have anxieties, tensions, fear and uncertainties. It is an important ministry of the church, but please do not wait until the last moment to request the sacrament, the sacrament can be administered at any time when someone is sick or housebound. Due to the busy schedule of Fr Louis, whilst he will always try his best to attend a request for the sacrament, it may not always be possible to come urgently if needed, Where possible, please make an appointment in advance to receive the sacrament by contacting the parish priest or parish secretary either by email or phone. Every month we also have an anointing Mass (alternately in St Chad's & St Ann's), so this is another opportunity to bring your loved ones for the anointing of the sick.
