Prayerful Greetings from Fr. Louis. The first commandment is, "Love your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind". The heart is considered the seat of all emotions, feeling, and thoughts; the soul stands for physical and psychological energy and life itself; and the mind signifies the intellectual aspects of a person. Undivided loyalty to God with one's whole being is demanded. Jesus links the second commandment, "love your neighbour as yourself" to the "greatest and first commandment" and teaches that love of God is expressed in love of neighbour. I should consider my neighbour's needs and problems as my own. Pope Francis comments, "He does not deliver us two formulas or two precepts; they are not precepts and formulas. He gives us two faces, or better, a single face: that of God that is reflected in many faces because in the face of every brother especially the smallest, fragile, helpless and needy there is the very image of the God". This week we also celebrate the solemnity of ALL SAINTS and The Commemoration of all the Faithful Departed (ALL SOULS). On the solemnity of All Saints, the Church celebrates the memory of countless holy men and women of varying origin and nationality, heroes and heroines of Christian faith and witness of Christian charity through their lives. This feast was instituted by Pope St. Boniface IV, in 609, to honour all the Saints known and unknown. On All Souls day the Church reminds us to recall and pray all those who have gone ahead of us to the Heavenly Court of God, especially those of our own family and all our near and dear ones. This day of commemoration began in 998 with annual prayers of the dead in the monastic communities, and gradually spreading across the Universal Church. Have a Blessed Sunday.
