## Sunday 11th February 2024 – 6th Sunday Ordinary Time B

Greetings and Prayers to you all. This week we begin another season, the Holy Season of Lent. A great opportunity for a reality check on the strength of the three pillars of our spiritual life: Prayer, Penance, and Almsgiving. *Prayer*: a personal encounter with God. We listen to Him actively and respond to Him generously. *Penance* is the joyful love of a heart wanting to give more. *Almsgiving* is reaching out the needy and sharing what we have. This is not an occasion to parade our spiritual activities before others. But a time to think and meditate what can I do for my God. As Pope Francis reminds us, Lent is a time of truth, a time to drop the mistakes we put on each day to appear perfect in the eyes of the world and to reject lies and hypocrisy. Lent is the high tide of God's grace. As we begin our Lent, we customarily receive ashes on our foreheads in the sign of the cross. The ashes mean I am a sinner and the Cross means I have a Saviour. So with profound faith let us acknowledge that with God, we will rise from our ashes, but without Him we are dust. This public mark signifies our turning again to God, seeking His mercy, forgiveness, and help. We hear the words: "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return." Yes, we cannot pretend otherwise. Therefore, on this Ash Wednesday, let us embrace our vulnerability, acknowledge our brokenness, and seek healing. Let us remember that we are dust, but we are also beloved children of God. May this season of Lent be a time of growth, renewal, and deepening our relationship with the everlasting love – God.
