Corpus Christi: Today's celebration of the Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) reminds us of the words of St. Thomas Aquinas "the greatest miracle that Christ ever worked on Earth... My Body... My Blood". We celebrate today Jesus' gift of the Eucharist, the Source and Summit of our life. The Holy Eucharist is a Covenant. In a contract there is equality. You give and get in return. In a covenant there is no such equality. The giver gives everything, receiving nothing; the recipient, gets everything giving nothing. The Holy Eucharist is a gift from the goodness, gratuity and generosity of Jesus.

The Holy Eucharist is a Banquet. How privileged we are to be invited to Church to take part in the nuptials of the Lamb, a foretaste of the Heavenly banquet.
